College of International Education

Director: Dr Sam S S Lau

The College of International Education (CIE), managed by the School of Continuing Education, was established in May 2000 by Hong Kong Baptist University. The Associate Degree offered by CIE provides an alternative route for secondary school leavers to continue their studies at the degree level. Upon completing the Associate Degree, students can apply for articulation into the UGC-funded senior places in Hong Kong via the NON-JUPAS route. Alternatively, AD graduates from CIE can articulate into the self-funded top-up degree programmes offered by HKBU or other institutions. They can also articulate to overseas programmes to complete their undergraduate degrees. Currently, CIE has over 30 partner universities in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, the United Kingdom and the United States.

ASSOCIATE DEGREE PROGRAMME

The Associate Degree Progamme is designed to provide students with a broad-based General Education as well as specialization in one discipline or knowledge area. There is a total of 23 Concentration Studies covering a wide range of academic disciplines which students can choose from. Students must complete 62 units which normally require two years of full-time study. Upon successful completion of the programme, students will be awarded the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science.

Teaching Approach and Medium of Instruction

In order to facilitate active learning and enhance learning effectiveness, a variety of student-oriented pedagogical approaches are adopted in CIE. Following the university-wide OBTL implementation, CIE adopts outcomes-based teaching and learning where teaching and learning activities (TLAs) and assessment methods (AMs) are constructively aligned to achieve the intended learning outcomes.

The College follows the University's Medium of Instruction policy as detailed in the section on "General Information."

Assessment Methods

CIE follows the HKBU Policy for Assessment of Student Learning. Students' performance is assessed by a variety of methods which are constructively aligned with the intended learning outcomes. Apart from the written final examination required by most courses, there are also continuous coursework assessments (e.g. short essays, research essays, case studies, presentations and projects) which allow ample formative and summative feedback to students.

Minimum Admission Requirements

- Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE): Level 2 in five subjects (including Chinese Language and English Language);or
- Hong Kong A-Level Examination (HKALE): 1 pass in one A-Level subject or 2 passes in two AS-Level subjects, and 3 passes in HKCEE plus Level 2 or above in Chinese Language and English Language; or
- 3. Associate Degree Foundation: Satisfactory completion of a Pre-Associate Degree / Associate Degree Foundation Programme; or
- 4. Yi Jin Diploma: Satisfactory completion of the Yi Jin Diploma; or
- 5. Other equivalent qualifications: Equivalent qualifications to be assessed by CIE; or
- 6. Aged 21 or above: Applicants aged 21 or above with acceptable qualifications to justify admission.
