Students are required to take four 3-unit elective courses.

Out of the four elective courses, three courses must be chosen from any of the following four groups #R-RPE-ELECT-002, #R-RPE-ELECT-003, #R-RPE-ELECT-004 or #R-RPE-ELECT-005 (Group II, III, IV or V). Only one course could be chosen from each group. The fourth course could be chosen from any elective course groups (Group I, II, III, IV or V).

Students are required to complete at least one 3-unit course at Level 3 or above.
