Terms of Reference

- (a) To encourage teaching staff to adopt innovative approaches to teaching and to improve the quality of the student learning.
- (b) To promote the enhancement of teaching and learning appropriate to the strategic direction of the University.
- (c) To encourage dissemination of good practice through publication across different genres and platforms including books, journal articles, seminars and conferences via print, digital formats and other appropriate technologies.
- (d) To support and generally oversee initiatives that promote scholarship of teaching and learning.
- (e) To formulate guidelines on the management of TDG funding, the processing of grant applications, and the administration of approved projects.
- (f) To assess TDG applications for their suitability to receive funding on the basis of relevance to the enhancement of teaching and learning.
- (g) To monitor grant recipients for compliance with the guidelines, including adherence to approved proposals, progress towards completion, and submission of final reports.
- (h) To submit an annual report to the Senate (via the Teaching and Learning Policy Committee).
