

SENATE

Terms of Reference

Subject to the provisions of the Ordinance and to the availability of the funds provided by the Council, the Senate shall have the following powers and duties:

- (a) To promote and provide guidance for the development of academic courses and programmes of study which are in line with the objects and educational philosophy of the University, and to keep the quality of such courses and programmes under constant review.
- (b) To promote and regulate the teaching, learning and research activities in the University.
- (c) To make regulations from time to time in respect of the following matters:
 - (i) the assessment of proposals for developing new courses and/or new subjects;
 - (ii) the conduct of examinations and other forms of assessment for students;
 - (iii) the admission, promotion, registration, graduation and residence of students;
 - (iv) the conditions for the academic awards of the University;
 - (v) the use of University libraries, laboratories, workshops and other educational facilities;
 - (vi) the award of student scholarships, bursaries and other prizes based on academic performance of the students.
- (d) To recommend to the Council the institution of awards of distinction for study or research.
- (e) To approve the appointment of external examiners.
- (f) To approve student graduation and the academic awards of the University in accordance with the Statutes and all relevant University regulations currently in force.
- (g) To require any student to terminate his studies at the University either on academic or disciplinary grounds, or on other grounds deemed as appropriate.
- (h) To decide on matters affecting the welfare and discipline of students.
- (i) To appoint committees and working parties to make reports and recommendations to the Senate for its decision.
- (j) To delegate any of its powers to any member or any committee of the Senate.
- (k) To determine its own meeting procedures, subject to the provisions of any statutes made by the Council with respect to the proceedings of the Senate pursuant to section 30(a) of the Ordinance.
- (l) To consider matters referred to the Senate by the Council.

- (m) To make recommendations to the Council on the establishment of faculties and schools.
