 - Grade E or above in GCE Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level or Advanced Level (AL) English; or
 - Grade C or above in GCE Ordinary Level (O Level)/GCSE/IGCSE English; or
 - Grade 3 in Joint Matriculation Board (JMB) University Test in English (or a pass in the NEAB University Entrance Test in English for Speakers of Other Languages); or
 - For applicants applying on the basis of qualifications other than HKALE, an English Language qualification equivalent to AS Use of English, as deemed acceptable by the University.
- For programmes which require a Grade D or above in AS Use of English, the University will accept the following qualifications as equivalent:
 - A score of 550 (paper-based) or 213 (computer-based) or 80 (internet-based) or above in TOEFL; or
 - A score of 7 or above in International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Academic Level; or
 - Grade D or above in GCE Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level or Advanced Level (AL) English; or
 - Grade C or above in GCE Ordinary Level (O Level)/GCSE/IGCSE English; or
 - For applicants applying on the basis of qualifications other than HKALE, an English Language qualification equivalent to AS Use of English, as deemed acceptable by the University.
- Applicants without Grade D or above in AS Use of English or equivalent qualifications are required to take the English Bridging Course before commencement of their studies at the University.
