**Notes:**

- The following public examination results are recognized by the University as equivalent to level 3 of HKDSE English Language for *ALL* programmes:
  - A score of 550 (paper-based) or 213 (computer-based) or 79 (internet-based) or above in TOEFL; or
  - A score of 6.5 or above in International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Academic Level; or
  - Grade C or above in GCE Ordinary Level (O Level)/GCSE/IGCSE English; or
  - Grade E or above in GCE Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level or Advanced Level (AL) English; or
  - Grade 3 in Joint Matriculation Board (JMB) University Test in English (or a pass in the NEAB University Entrance Test in English for Speakers of Other Languages); or
  - Grade E or above in HKALE Use of English (AS Use of English); or
  - Other English Language qualifications deemed acceptable by the University.
- For students who have not obtained Level 4 or above in HKDSE English Language or an equivalent qualification, they are required to take the English Bridging Course before commencement of their studies at the University.
