ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTANCY

Aim

The curriculum aims at providing students with an education which has a proper balance of breadth and depth in the accounting discipline and preparing them for their future career in accounting or accounting-related areas or further studies. It is designed to combine a substantial element of general education, a wide selection of business courses, as well as vigorous emphasis in professional accountancy training.

Teaching Approach and Medium of Instruction

A variety of pedagogical approaches and diversified teaching methods that are learner-based, motivating, and interactive will be adopted by lecturers of the programmes to enhance learning effectiveness. Audio-visual aids, multimedia technology, group work and hands-on simulated learning activities will be used to ensure students' involvement and learning in the process.

English is the medium of instruction used for all courses in the Programme except for Chinese Language and Culture courses, and some courses within the concentrations in Bilingual Language and Literature Studies and Chinese for Professional Purposes. Courses related to China and Hong Kong within the concentrations in Film, Television and Digital Media Studies and Journalism may be taught bilingually as deemed appropriate.

Assessment Methods

The programmes follow the grade point average system (GPA) set by the Hong Kong Baptist University to assess coursework and examination performance. Students' performance is assessed by a variety of methods. Besides the requirement of a final written examination for most courses, continuous coursework assessment which includes interim tests and quizzes, short essays, case studies, individual and group presentations, projects and hands-on simulated exercises will be used to optimize successful learning.

Minimum Admission Requirements

1. One A-Level or an equivalent number of AS Level subjects, and three passes in HKCEE plus Level two or above in Chinese Language and English Language (or five passes in HKCEE including Chinese Language and English [Syllabus B] in pre-2007 HKCEE); or
2. Satisfactory completion of a Pre-Associate Degree/ Foundation Programme; or
3. Other equivalent qualifications to be assessed by the College of International Education; or
4. Applicants aged 21 or above, with acceptable evidence to justify admission.
